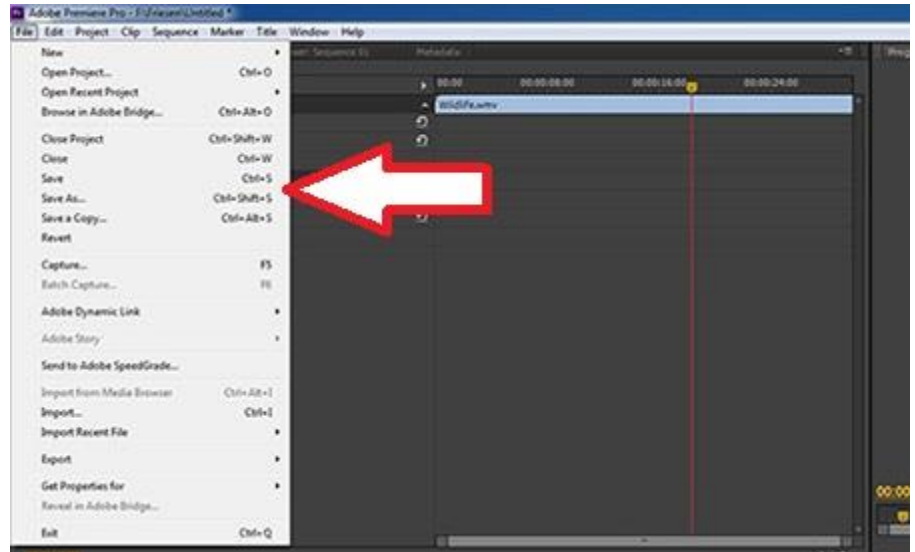


Tech Training: Premiere Saving & Exporting

Save the Project

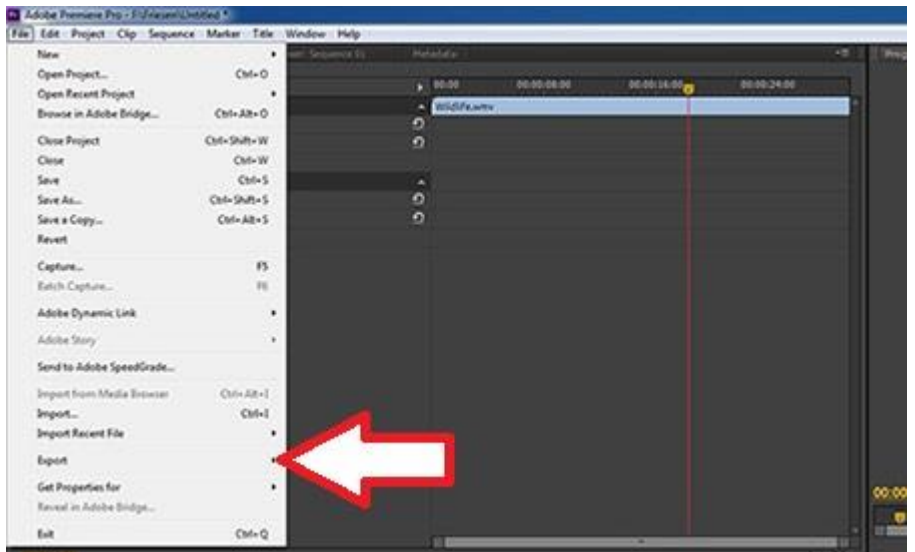
Saving your project is very important and will allow you to recover from a possible crash.

Saving a project in Premiere is only saving it as a project file. This means all cuts, tweaks and edits are not happening to the files as they are added, but are merely a collection of what needs to be done. When a project is rendered/exported as a DVD or file, then all changes come together to make the new media.



Create Video/Audio File

- File > Export > Media Encoder



Create DVD/Blu-ray

- File > Adobe Dynamic Link > Send to Encore
